What is the Census Partner Portal?

- A one-stop shop for the Census Bureau to connect, communicate and engage with the participants of various geographic programs.
- A communication platform for the Census partners to send/receive any correspondence and to post any program notifications and announcements.
- A secured portal for external partners at tribal, state, and local governments to access entity-specific partnership program information, including geospatial data, historical program participation information, and contact updates

Purpose of Partner Portal

- Build knowledge, manage opportunities, create demand marketing, influence behavior, apply to the partner program, and assist buyers. Each area addressing these functions contains basic, intermediate, and advanced features, as well as individualized content for every partner
- A partner portal is similar to a customer self-service portal, in that it allows partners to help themselves

Research Findings

Common Features

- Dashboard with Activity Updates
- Communication Tools: email, real-time chatting, messaging
- Self Help Features (knowledge articles, self-training materials)
- File download/upload
- Analytical tools and reports
- Security/user login (single sign on)
- App integrations: access other application data

Measures for a Successful Partner Portal

- Three pillars of a successful portal: the platform, the content, and the support
 - Platform: the physical site: what it looks like and how it acts
 - Content: what the partners can access and interact with on the portal
 - Support: Robust partner support mechanisms

What Partners Look for in Partner Portal

- Ease of Use: An easy-to-use, mobile-friendly partner portal is essential for partner success
- Effective Content Organization: makes most visited sections highly accessible and easy to use
- Feedback Center: give partners an opportunity to communicate openly
